Background: Christian Singer Songwriter Ken Robertson grew up on a steady diet of the great hymns of the church, heavy doses of Southern Gospel, country and western, Johnny Cash, Elvis, and 1950's rock. In early life, the Robertson family singers (dad, mom, brother, sister and Ken) performed at local church functions. Ken performed with the Joint Heirs, a busy Southern Gospel quartet, and later joined Mark Allen and the Gospel Train, a Bluegrass Gospel band. Ken has appeared as a solo performer, and participated in local church choirs, praise and worship bands, and benefit events. He enjoys a great story song, and any song with a sense of humor or a surprise twist.
